The WOCA is a multi- issue, multi-cultural, grassroots women of color organization devoted to addressing the intersections of race, class, gender, ethnicity, sexual orientation, and other markers of difference. Through training, workshops, coalition building, public education campaigns, community organizing, and resource leveraging/sharing, we strive to help end all forms of oppression and promote social justice. Our goal is to bring women/girls of color, diverse communities, and organizations together to work towards a multi-issue agenda for social, economic, and political change.

The WOCA seeks a diverse group of women/girls, with regards to race, class, ethnicity, sexuality, geographic location, and age, who are active in their communities and possess a strong commitment to social justices and women/girls of color. Young Women are encouraged to apply.
